DETERMINE QUORUM; CALL TO ORDER

Director Reyes noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board considered approval of the minutes of September 25, 2017. Following discussion, upon a motion made by Director Cavazos and seconded by Director Zamarripa, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of September 25, 2017.

ENGAGE AUDITOR FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2018

Mr. Jenkins then presented an engagement letter from McCall Gibson Swedlund Barfoot, PLLC to conduct the Authority's audit for fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, noting a cost range of \$7,250-\$8,000. Following discussion, upon a motion made by Director Burke and seconded by Director Cavazos, the Board voted unanimously to approve the audit engagement letter presented by Mr. Jenkins.

AGREEMENT WITH EQUI-TAX INC.

Mr. Lord presented the proposed agreement between the Authority and Equi-Tax Inc. Mr. DeLeon explained that Equi-Tax would examine the tax rolls to identify any properties that were not coded to the Authority. After discussion, Director Burke moved that the Board approve the agreement with Equi-Tax as presented. Director Cavazos seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.

CONTRACT WITH JONES CARTER FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Board next considered an agreement with Jones Carter for engineering services. After discussion, Director Burke moved that the Board approve the agreement as presented. Director Zamarripa seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.

AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR HERNANDEZ TUNNEL

Mr. Lord informed the Board that the original interlocal agreement with the City must be amended to provide for a second phase of work which includes the rehabilitation of Hernandez Tunnel. He presented the First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement for the Board's review. After review and discussion, Director Burke moved that the Board approve the First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement. Director Cavazos seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

CONSTRUCTION PAYMENT APPROVAL PROCESS

The Board next discussed procedures for approving construction pay estimates relating to the Hernandez Tunnel. After discussion, Director Cavazos moved the Board authorize Directors Reyes, Zamarippa and Burke to approve construction pay estimates that are submitted outside of Authority meetings. Director Burke seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

MURAL FOR HERNANDEZ TUNNEL

Mr. Lord presented an interlocal agreement between the Authority and Greater Northside Management District (the "District") relating the proposed mural for the Hernandez Tunnel providing that the Authority will pay one-half of the cost of the mural up to \$15,000. After discussion, Director Burke moved that the Board approve the Interlocal Agreement with the District as presented. Director Zamarripa seconded the motion and it carried by unanimous vote.

BOOKKEEPER'S REPORT

Ms. Salinas then presented the bookkeeper's report and invoices submitted for payment to the Board for review and approval. A copy of the bookkeeper's report is attached to these minutes.

Following discussion on the bookkeeper's report and the invoices submitted for payment, upon a motion made by Director Burke and seconded by Director Cavazos, the Board voted unanimously to approve the bookkeeper's report and the invoices submitted for payment.

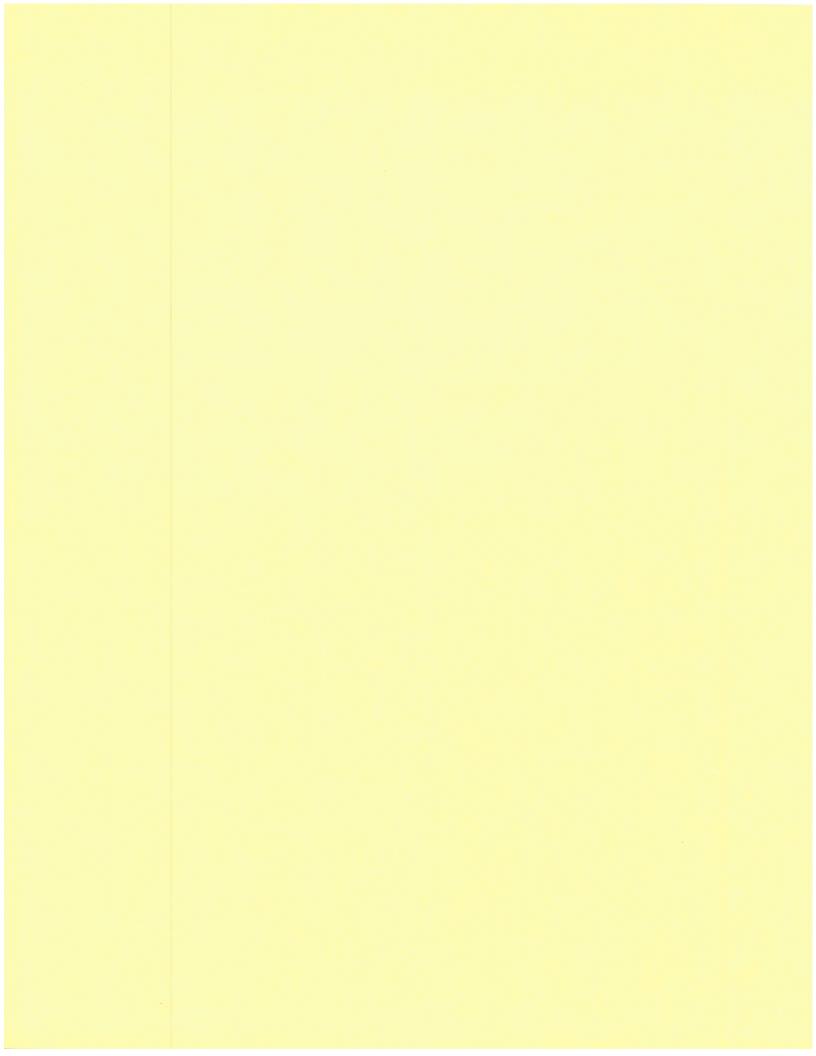
